ANTIOCHUS Daniel 11:22-35

-We don't typically read the end of the Old Testament, or study the time between the Old and New Testaments, yet it these times that set perspective to the Gospels and to our future.

-The Bible is very clear that there are difficult days ahead, but in the end, this all leads to **victory**, to **eternity**, and ultimately, <u>we will get to witness **glory**</u>.

<u>Revelation 13:15</u> (ESV) And it was allowed to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast might even speak <u>and might cause those who would</u> <u>not worship the image of the beast to be slain</u>.

Daniel 11:32 (ESV) He shall seduce with flattery those who violate the covenant, **but the people who know their God** <u>shall stand firm and take action</u>.

<u>2 Thessalonians 2:3–4</u> (ESV) Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, ⁴ who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God.

ANTICHRIST Daniel 11:36-12:2

Antiochus/Antichrist

- 1. Antiochus does not disregard his own gods.
- 2. Antiochus IS the king of the North.
- 3. Both Antichrist and Antiochus are "little horns."

Antichrist

- Self-centered, successful & progressive
- God allots Antichrist a certain amount of time to prosper
- "gods of his fathers" he will disregard old ways & gods

-The antichrist will have no regard for God or His Son.

-Although the details of the end are debated, the reminder is that our destiny is victory and no matter how dark the days get, they will end in celebration.

<u>Zechariah 12:10</u> (ESV) "And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and pleas for mercy, so that, **when they look on me, on him whom they have pierced**, they shall mourn for him, as one mourns <u>for an only</u> <u>child</u>, and weep bitterly over him, as one weeps over a <u>firstborn</u>.

Zechariah 14:4 (ESV) On that day his feet shall stand on the Mount of Olives that lies before Jerusalem on the east, and the Mount of Olives shall be split in two from east to west by a very wide valley, so that one half of the Mount shall move northward, and the other half southward.

-At the end of all things, there is a resurrection of the dead, both godly and ungodly. Those in Him are with Him and those apart from Him, He will tell them to depart.

-There are two places where your sin and mine are judged. It's one or the other. We will carry our sins to hell, or we will carry them to the cross.

Ezekiel 33:11 (ESV) Say to them, As I live, declares the Lord GOD, <u>I have no pleasure in</u> the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways, for why will you die, O house of Israel?

-If what is in store for the world is a self-confident, self-focused, prideful, powerhungry atheist who has no regard for the God of his fathers, the world today seems primed to follow him.
