-When we know more about pop culture than we do history, we are on the cusp of abandoning what made us who we are.

***Judges 2:10 (ESV)** And all that generation also were gathered to their fathers. And there arose another generation after them who did not know the LORD or the work that he had done for Israel.*

WE HAVE HEARD *Psalm 44:1-8*

-In the most spiritual sense of its meaning, the Church was never meant to be exclusively defensive in its nature. It was also meant to be offensive.

***Matthew 16:18-19 (ESV)** And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, **and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.** ¹⁹ I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."*

-Do you think it is possible that when some Christians declare we are in the **end times**, that it is because they **don't believe God can revive** the generation we are living in?

-Revival will always come **from God, through the believer** who desperately wants **God's will** and **God's love** visible in their generation.

-There is an **expectation by God** for the faith given to you to **mean something!** God is going to **ask you** what you did with your **faith**.

-We should **never imagine** that our work here is done **if Christ hasn't returned**.

-Revivals **are not orchestrated**, they are **not planned**, but they are **always in God's timing** and **done His way**.

-Revivals begin with a **deep and supernatural brokenness for our sins**, in order that God can **reshape us to His purposes by His presence**.

-Do you think we are a modern **Judges 2:10** generation that has forgotten the work God has done?
